Nonprofit Leadership and Management (NPLM) Youth Academy

Programme Overview

The Nonprofit Leadership and Management Youth Academy Programme is targeted at young and emerging nonprofit leaders aged 18 - 35 in Africa. Participants learn about feminist leadership principles, skills to grow their organisations and movements, and lead important social innovation initiatives with refined tools and greater confidence to build purposeful careers in the nonprofit sector.

Participants are equipped with the skills required to elevate their voices and enable them respond to the intersectional challenges they are faced with in society. The programme has been designed to cultivate three pillars of competencies required to lead a nonprofit organisation - leadership effectiveness, business fundamentals, and social innovation. Participants will have an immersive learning experience in leadership and strategic planning, exploring nonprofit organisational development; human resources and volunteer management; financial stewardship and corporate governance.

Key Learning Outcomes / Takeaways

The nonprofit management for senior executives participants will:

- Gain a deeper understanding of nonprofit leadership skills, including how to define strong mission statements, manage operational and financial controls, improve organisational capacity, strengthen fundraising and revenue generation efforts, marketing, volunteer management, governance and sustainability
- Understand the fundamentals of accounting and sustainable finance for nonprofit organisations, including concepts such as budgeting, reporting, strategic planning, programme analysis and fund accounting
- Explore numerous fundraising options and how to access them through grant writing, prospect research, communications, capital campaigns, etc. Your exposure to nonprofit management theories and practices would also involve case study discussions, videos and field visits
